



Building and improving on Age of Wonders, Shadow Magic contains a lot of the same 4X gameplay with some of the irritating kinks of the original Age of Wonders ironed out. I was a little disappointed that, unlike the original, there is no "evil" campaign, but the gameplay is solid and even improved. I'd say you might even want to skip the original and go straight to this one.. Really beautiful and interesting HOG inspired by Prince of Persia.

First 18+ game on Steam I purchased, and it's 222222. I'm a bit surprised by the negativity in the other reviews, especially when it goes to writing - I think this game presents a very fine and believable story, even if it has some issues endemic to NWG titles (like unnecessary, mundane descriptions and scenes that clog much of the first 20-30 minutes of the VN). It's also particularly simple when it goes to the visual side of things and the voice acting feels a tiny bit off (especially for James, mostly because of the recording quality), but never to the point of being actually off-putting and considering what kind of plot it tries to communicate, I didn't mind it being a bit clunky.

It's also not a surprising story really - after the first "dramatic coincident" on the part of Isobel and early complications from her lies you can get a feeling on what kind of person she is and in what ways the story could end. It is, however, quite an emotional one and I truly felt for the protagonist and the emotional abuse she went through throughout the whole plot. There are only a few choices, but they show up in the crucial part of the story and are very strongly connected to its main theme, so I didn't really mind the relative linearity of it all. It's also a fairly short game (my playtime is bloated through a few hours of being AFK), so after you get through the slow start it doesn't ever get tedious or boring.

In general, while it definitely doesn't offer much visual flair, it's a pretty interesting VN and considering how cheap it is nowadays, I recommend giving it a try (at least of toxic relationship drama is something you like to read). I'll also mention that I didn't install the h-patch, but from what I read here, you don't lose much by skipping it and I'm not even sure if I'd ever want explicit scenes in this kind of story - what is most important here, is that it, in my opinion, works fine as "just" drama and is worth buying even without the smutty parts.

Hired OP is basically useless because Form up is a janky thing, and the missiles are very RNG on if they are actually going to hit the guy twenty foot in front of you or just spazz out and go wherever.. Nice model, but the whistle is from a Pennsylvania Railroad J1. (The proper whistle can be found on Railworks America.) Textures are a little sloppy, but it's not too bad. The biggest issue for me is the WWII scenarios don't match the model. In 1947, the PRR "modernized" the K4 fleet. This DLC models the "modernized" (post war) K4... however the WWII scenarios take place before 1947, so the locomotive should be modeled to look like the original (pre war) K4. The most noticable difference between the two was that the headlight on the pre war K4 was on the front of the smokebox with the steam generator behind it. When modernization took place, the headlight was located on top of the smokebox and the steam generator on the front, to allow easier access for maintenance. A platform was also added to the front of the smokebox to allow easy access to the generator. In my opinion. I would have payed a little bit more to have both the pre war and post war verisons of the K4, but great DLC nontheless... what a great scary game to play. One Deck Dungeon is a card game that has been brought into the digital realm pretty well. It is a dice based game of fighting monsters as 1 or 2 characters using a single deck for the whole journey. Despite how it may seem, this is not an easy game, nor is it intended to be. Expect to be killed a fair amount of times before you get the hang of it but once you learn the tricks, gotten the hang of the skills, and all that stuff, this game wont be too hard. It's a great game for those who enjoy a decent challenge with the ever looming threat of RNGesus messing you up (It is dice after all).

The core game is done, but as of now there are several bits of additional content in the works containing a new boss and a few playable characters (including a cameo from Sentinels of the Multiverse, also work by Handelabra).. I really like the game. It is a good and fun way to kill the time.

One thing that I do not like is that you can not change the direction of the branches so they do not always fit where I want them to.. This was one of my first VR titles and I was pretty impressed with it for the most part. The narrative was decent and the production values were strong. It's on the short side (I have finished it once) and while the quality was good the interactivity is a bit limited. If you are looking for an on-rails VR experience piloting a stompy mech and shooting at lots of things this is probably what you want. Note that the content is somewhat adult oriented and there is some mild language that may be too much for younger kids, though tweens and teens should be fine. I wish I could give this a neutral rating based on the interactivity, content length and price point but that's not possible so I am voting thumbs up but would encourage waiting for a sale or a price drop and knowing what you are getting in to.
